<u>What is God's plan for Israel?</u> God's plan is that Israel would become a multitude (KJV) of peoples.

- Genesis 20:1-3 The LORD had said to Abram, "Leave your country, your people and your father's household and go to the land I will show you. I will make you into a great nation and I will bless you; I will make your name great, and you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and whoever curses you I will curse; and <u>all peoples on earth will be blessed through you</u>."
- Genesis 28:3 May God Almighty bless you and make you fruitful and increase your numbers until you become a <u>community ["multitude" KJV] of peoples</u>.
- Genesis 48:4 and said to me, 'I am going to make you fruitful and will increase your numbers. I will make you a <u>community ["multitude" KJV] of peoples</u>, and I will give this land as an everlasting possession to your descendants after you.'

<u>Where would Israel live?</u> Israel would be given a literal land as an inheritance by God forever.

- Genesis 48:4 and said to me, 'I am going to make you fruitful and will increase your numbers. I will make you a community of peoples, and <u>I will give this land as an everlasting possession</u> to your descendants after you.'
- Leviticus 20:24 But I said to you, "<u>You will possess their land; I will give it to you as an</u> <u>inheritance</u>, a land flowing with milk and honey." I am the LORD your God, who has set you apart from the nations.
- Deut. 26:15 Look down from heaven, your holy dwelling place, and bless your people Israel and <u>the land you have given us</u> as you promised on oath to our forefathers, a land flowing with milk and honey.
- 1 Kings 8:33-34 "When your people Israel have been defeated by an enemy because they have sinned against you, and when they turn back to you and confess your name, praying and making supplication to you in this temple, then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of your people Israel and <u>bring them back to the land you gave to their fathers</u>.
- 2 Chron. 6:27 ...then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of your servants, your people Israel. Teach them the right way to live, and <u>send rain on the land you gave your people for an</u> <u>inheritance</u>.
- 2 Chron. 7:14 if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal <u>their land</u>. [Note: This verse cannot be a reference to the United States or any other nation except for Israel.]
- Nehemiah 1:8 –" Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them from there and <u>bring them to the place</u> I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name.' They are your servants and your people, whom you redeemed by your great strength and your mighty hand."

Psalm 135:12 - ...and he gave their land as an inheritance, an inheritance to his people Israel.

- Isaiah 49:8-9 This is what the LORD says: "In the time of my favor I will answer you, and in the day of salvation I will help you; I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people, <u>to restore the land and to reassign its desolate inheritances</u>, to say to the captives, 'Come out,' and to those in darkness, 'Be free!' "They will feed beside the roads and find pasture on every barren hill.
- Isaiah 60:21 Then will all your people be righteous <u>and they will possess the land forever</u>. They are the shoot I have planted, the work of my hands, for the display of my splendor.
- Jeremiah 30:3 The days are coming,' declares the LORD, 'when I will bring my people Israel and Judah back from captivity and <u>restore them to the land I gave their forefathers to</u> <u>possess</u>,' says the LORD..."
- Jeremiah 32:37-38 I will surely gather them from all the lands where I banish them in my furious anger and great wrath; <u>I will bring them back to this place</u> and let them live in safety. They will be my people, and I will be their God.
- Jeremiah 50:6 My people have been lost sheep; their shepherds have led them astray and caused them to roam on the mountains. They wandered over mountain and hill and forgot <u>their own resting place</u>.
- Ezekiel 11:17 Therefore say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: I will gather you from the nations and bring you back from the countries where you have been scattered, and <u>I will give you back the land of Israel again</u>.'
- Ezekiel 28:25 This is what the Sovereign LORD says: When I gather the people of Israel from the nations where they have been scattered, I will show myself holy among them in the sight of the nations. Then they will live in their own land, which I gave to my servant Jacob.
- Ezekiel 34:13 I will bring them out from the nations and gather them from the countries, and I will bring them into <u>their own land</u>. I will pasture them <u>on the mountains of Israel, in the ravines and in all the settlements in the land</u>.
- Ezekiel 36:12 I will cause people, my people Israel, to walk upon you [the land]. <u>They will</u> <u>possess you, and you will be their inheritance</u>; you will never again deprive them of their children.
- Ezekiel 36:28 <u>You will live in the land I gave your forefathers;</u> you will be my people, and I will be your God.
- Ezekiel 45:8 <u>This land will be his possession in Israel</u>. And my princes will no longer oppress my people but will allow the house of Israel to <u>possess the land according to their tribes</u>.
- Hosea 1:9-11 Then the LORD said, "Call him Lo-Ammi, for you are not my people, and I am not your God. Yet the Israelites will be like the sand on the seashore, which cannot be measured or counted. In the place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' they will be called 'sons of the living God.' The people of Judah and the people of Israel will be reunited, and they will appoint one leader and <u>will come up out of the land</u>, for great will be the day of Jezreel.

- Amos 9:14-15 I will bring back my exiled people Israel<u>; they will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them</u>. They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; they will make gardens and eat their fruit. <u>I will plant Israel in their own land, never again to be uprooted from the land I have given them</u>," says the LORD your God.
- Zephaniah 2:9 "Therefore, as surely as I live," declares the LORD Almighty, the God of Israel, "surely Moab will become like Sodom, the Ammonites like Gomorrah— a place of weeds and salt pits, a wasteland forever. The remnant of my people will plunder them; the survivors of my nation <u>will inherit their land</u>."
- Zechariah 8:7-8 This is what the LORD Almighty says: "I will save my people from the countries of the east and the west. I will bring them back to live in Jerusalem; they will be my people, and I will be faithful and righteous to them as their God."

Who is Ephraim?

- Ephraim is the younger son of Joseph, predicted to become greater than his older brother Manasseh. His descendants would become a group ("multitude" KJV) of nations. Ephraim is often another name for the ten northern tribes of Israel, which were dispersed throughout the world because of their disobedience and idolatry. They are often called "Israel."
- Genesis 48:19 But his father refused and said, "I know, my son, I know. He too will become a people, and he too will become great. Nevertheless, <u>his younger brother will be greater than he, and his descendants will become a group of nations</u>." (speaking of Ephraim and Manasseh)
- Deut. 33:17 In majesty he is like a firstborn bull; his horns are the horns of a wild ox. With them he will gore the nations, even those at the ends of the earth. Such are the ten thousands of Ephraim; such are the thousands of Manasseh.

Isaiah 7:8 - Within sixty-five years Ephraim will be too shattered to be a people.

Hosea 7:8 - Ephraim mixes with the nations; Ephraim is a flat cake not turned over.

Who is Judah?

- Judah is the son of Israel from whose tribe a ruler would come, whom all nations would obey. Judah is often another name for the two southern tribes of Israle, which were carried away to Babylon, then restored to the land, only to be dispersed throughout the world after the fall of Jerusalem in AD 70. They are often called "Jews."
- Genesis 49:10 The <u>scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff</u> from between his feet, until he comes to whom it belongs and the obedience of the nations is his.
- 2 Sam. 5:12 And David [from the tribe of Judah] knew that the LORD had established him as <u>king over Israel</u> and had exalted his kingdom for the sake of his people Israel.
- Psalm 148:14 He has raised up for his people <u>a horn</u> [or ruler], the praise of all his saints, of Israel, the people close to his heart. Praise the LORD.

- Isaiah 11:10-11, 16 In that day <u>the Root of Jesse</u> will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and his place of rest will be glorious. In that day the Lord will reach out his hand a second time to reclaim the remnant that is left of his people from Assyria, from Lower Egypt, from Upper Egypt, from Cush, from Elam, from Babylonia, from Hamath and from the islands of the sea... There will be a highway for the remnant of his people that is left from Assyria, as there was for Israel when they came up from Egypt.
- Hosea 1:9-11 Then the LORD said, "Call him Lo-Ammi, for you are not my people, and I am not your God. Yet the Israelites will be like the sand on the seashore, which cannot be measured or counted. In the place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' they will be called 'sons of the living God.' The people of Judah and the people of Israel will be reunited, and <u>they will appoint one leader</u> and will come up out of the land, for great will be the day of Jezreel.
- Matthew 2:6 But you, Bethlehem<u>, in the land of Judah</u>, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; <u>for out of you will come a ruler who will be the shepherd of my people Israel</u>.
- Luke 1:68-75 Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel, because he has come and has redeemed his people. <u>He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David (as</u> <u>he said through his holy prophets of long ago)</u>, salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us—to show mercy to our fathers and to remember his holy covenant, the oath he swore to our father Abraham: to rescue us from the hand of our enemies, and to enable us to serve him without fear in holiness and righteousness before him all our days.
- Romans 15:8-12 For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs so that the Gentiles may glorify God for his mercy, as it is written: "Therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles; I will sing hymns to your name." Again, it says, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people." And again, "Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and sing praises to him, all you peoples." And again, Isaiah says, "<u>The Root of Jesse will spring up, one who will arise to rule over the nations</u>; the Gentiles will hope in him."

<u>What are some special characteristics of the children of Israel?</u> They are the people of God. Note that these are literal descendants of Israel, yet believers in Jesus from all nations are included in the designation, "people of God."

- Exodus 6:7 <u>I will take you as my own people</u>, and I will be your God. Then you will know that I am the LORD your God, who brought you out from under the yoke of the Egyptians.
- Exodus 15:16 ...terror and dread will fall upon them. By the power of your arm they will be as still as a stone— until <u>your people</u> pass by, O LORD, until the people you bought pass by.
- Exodus 33:13, 16 If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you. Remember that <u>this nation is your people</u>... How will anyone know that you are pleased with me and with <u>your people</u> unless you go with us? What else will distinguish me and <u>your people</u> from all the other people on the face of the earth?

Leviticus 26:12 - I will walk among you and be your God, and you will be my people.

- Deut. 9:29 But they are your people, your inheritance that you brought out by your great power and your outstretched arm.
- Deut. 26:18-19 And the LORD has declared this day that <u>you are his people</u>, his treasured possession as he promised, and that you are to keep all his commands. He has declared that he will set you in praise, fame and honor high above all the nations he has made and that you will be a people holy to the LORD your God, as he promised.
- Deut. 27:9 Then Moses and the priests, who are Levites, said to all Israel, "Be silent, O Israel, and listen! You have now become the people of the LORD your God.
- Deut. 29:13 ...to confirm you this day <u>as his people</u>, that he may be your God as he promised you and as he swore to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.
- 1 Sam. 12:22 For the sake of his great name the LORD will not reject <u>his people</u>, because the LORD was pleased <u>to make you his own</u>.
- 2 Sam. 5:12 And David knew that the LORD had established him as king over Israel and had exalted his kingdom for the sake of <u>his people Israel</u>.
- 2 Sam. 7:23-24 And who is like <u>your people Israel</u>—the one nation on earth that God went out to redeem as <u>a people for himself</u>, and to make a name for himself, and to perform great and awesome wonders by driving out nations and their gods from before <u>your people</u>, <u>whom you</u> <u>redeemed from Egypt</u>? <u>You have established your people Israel as your very own forever</u>, and you, O LORD, have become their God.
- 1 Kings 8:51-53 ...for <u>they are your people</u> and your inheritance, whom you brought out of Egypt, out of that iron-smelting furnace. May your eyes be open to your servant's plea and to the plea of <u>your people Israel</u>, and may you listen to them whenever they cry out to you. For you singled them out from all the nations of the world to be your own inheritance, just as you declared through your servant Moses when you, O Sovereign LORD, brought our fathers out of Egypt.
- 1 Chron. 17:21-22 And who is like <u>your people Israel</u>—the one nation on earth whose God went out to redeem <u>a people for himself</u>, and to make a name for yourself, and to perform great and awesome wonders by driving out nations from before <u>your people</u>, whom you redeemed from Egypt? <u>You made your people Israel your very own forever</u>, and you, O LORD, have become their God.
- Nehemiah 1:8 "Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then even if <u>your exiled people</u> are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name.' They are your servants and <u>your people</u>, whom you redeemed by your great strength and your mighty hand."
- Psalm 95:7 ...for he is our God and we are the people of his pasture, the flock under his care.
- Psalm 148:14 He has raised up for <u>his people</u> a horn, the praise of all his saints, of <u>Israel, the</u> <u>people close to his heart</u>. Praise the LORD.

Isaiah 40:1 - Comfort, comfort my people, says your God.

- Isaiah 43:20-21 The wild animals honor me, the jackals and the owls, because I provide water in the desert and streams in the wasteland, to give drink to <u>my people</u>, <u>my chosen</u>, <u>the people</u> <u>I formed for myself</u> that they may proclaim my praise.
- Isaiah 52:9 Burst into songs of joy together, you ruins of Jerusalem, for the LORD has comforted <u>his people</u>, he has redeemed Jerusalem.
- Jeremiah 13:11 For as a belt is bound around a man's waist, so I bound the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah to me,' declares the LORD, <u>'to be my people</u> for my renown and praise and honor. But they have not listened.'
- Jeremiah 24:7 I will give them a heart to know me, that I am the LORD. <u>They will be my</u> <u>people</u>, and I will be their God, for they will return to me with all their heart.
- Ezekiel 11:20 Then they will follow my decrees and be careful to keep my laws. <u>They will be my people</u>, and I will be their God.
- Ezekiel 14:11 Then <u>the people of Israel</u> will no longer stray from me, nor will they defile themselves anymore with all their sins. <u>They will be my people</u>, and I will be their God, declares the Sovereign LORD.'
- Ezekiel 34:30-31 Then they will know that I, the LORD their God, am with them and <u>that they</u>, <u>the house of Israel</u>, are my people, declares the Sovereign LORD. You my sheep, the sheep of my pasture, are <u>people</u>, and I am your God, declares the Sovereign LORD.'
- Ezekiel 36:12 I will cause <u>people, my people Israel</u>, to walk upon you. They will possess you, and you will be their inheritance; you will never again deprive them of their children.
- Ezekiel **36:28** You will live in the land I gave your forefathers; <u>you will be my people</u>, and I will be your God.
- Ezekiel 37:22-23 I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel. There will be one king over all of them and they will never again be two nations or be divided into two kingdoms. They will no longer defile themselves with their idols and vile images or with any of their offenses, for I will save them from all their sinful backsliding, and I will cleanse them. <u>They will be my people</u>, and I will be their God.
- Ezekiel 37:26-28 I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant. I will establish them and increase their numbers, and I will put my sanctuary among them forever. My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and <u>they will be my people</u>. Then the nations will know that I the LORD make Israel holy, when my sanctuary is among them forever.'
- Ezekiel 39:7-8 I will make known my holy name among <u>my people Israel</u>. I will no longer let my holy name be profaned, and the nations will know that I the LORD am the Holy One in Israel. It is coming! It will surely take place, declares the Sovereign LORD. This is the day I have spoken of.

- Daniel 9:19 O Lord, listen! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, hear and act! For your sake, O my God, do not delay, because your city and <u>your people</u> bear your Name.
- Hosea 2:23 I will plant her for myself in the land; I will show my love to the one I called 'Not my loved one.' I will say to those called 'Not my people,' <u>'You are my people'</u>; and they will say, 'You are my God.'
- Zechariah 8:7-8 This is what the LORD Almighty says: "I will save <u>my people</u> from the countries of the east and the west. I will bring them back to live in Jerusalem; they will be <u>my people</u>, and I will be faithful and righteous to them as their God."
- Zechariah 13:9 This third I will bring into the fire; I will refine them like silver and test them like gold. They will call on my name and I will answer them; I will say, <u>'They are my people</u>,' and they will say, 'The LORD is our God.'
- Romans 9:23-26 What if he did this to make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy, whom he prepared in advance for glory—even us, whom he also called, <u>not only from the Jews but also from the Gentiles</u>? As he says in Hosea: "I will call them <u>'my people</u>' who are not my people; and I will call her 'my loved one' who is not my loved one," and, "It will happen that in the very place where it was said to them, "You are not my people,' they will be called 'sons of the living God."
- 2 Corinthians 6:16-18 What agreement is there between the temple of God and idols? For we are the temple of the living God. As God has said: "I will live with them and walk among them, and I will be their God, and <u>they will be my people</u>." "Therefore come out from them and be separate, says the Lord. Touch no unclean thing, and I will receive you." "I will be a Father to you, and you will be my sons and daughters, says the Lord Almighty."
- Ephesians 2:19 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and <u>members of God's household</u>.
- Ephesians 4:4-6 There is one body and one Spirit—just as you were called to one hope when you were called—one Lord, one faith, one baptism; <u>one God and Father of all</u>, who is over all and through all and in all.
- Titus 2:14 ...who gave himself for us to redeem us from all wickedness and to purify for himself <u>a people that are his very own</u>, eager to do what is good.
- Hebrews 4:19 There remains, then, a Sabbath-rest for the people of God ...
- 1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen <u>people</u>, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, <u>a people</u> <u>belonging to God</u>, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. <u>Once you were not a people</u>, <u>but now you are the people of God</u>; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
- Revelation 21:3-4 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. <u>They will be his people</u>, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

They are a kingdom of priests.

- Exodus 19:5-6 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, you will be for me <u>a kingdom</u> <u>of priests</u> and a holy nation.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."
- 1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen people, <u>a royal priesthood</u>, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.
- Revelation 5:9-10 And they sang a new song: "You are worthy to take the scroll and to open its seals, because you were slain, and with your blood you purchased men for God from every tribe and language and people and nation. You have made them to be <u>a kingdom and priests</u> to serve our God, and they will reign on the earth."

They are a holy [set apart] nation.

- Exodus 19:5-6 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, you will be for me a kingdom of priests and <u>a holy nation</u>.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."
- Exodus 33:13, 16 If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so I may know you and continue to find favor with you. Remember that this nation is your people... How will anyone know that you are pleased with me and with your people unless you go with us? What else will <u>distinguish me and your people</u> from all the other people on the face of the earth?
- Leviticus 20:24 But I said to you, "You will possess their land; I will give it to you as an inheritance, a land flowing with milk and honey." I am the LORD your God, who has <u>set you apart from the nations</u>.
- Leviticus 20:26 You are to be <u>holy</u> to me because I, the LORD, am holy, and I <u>have set you</u> <u>apart from the nations</u> to be my own.
- Deut. 7:6-7 For you are a people <u>holy</u> to the LORD your God. The LORD your God has chosen you <u>out of all the peoples on the face of the earth</u> to be his people, his treasured possession. The LORD did not set his affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples.
- Deut. 14:2 ...for you are <u>a people holy to the LORD your God</u>. Out of all the peoples on the face of the earth, the LORD has chosen you to be his treasured possession.
- Deut. 14:21 Do not eat anything you find already dead. You may give it to an alien living in any of your towns, and he may eat it, or you may sell it to a foreigner. But <u>you are a people holy</u> to the LORD your God. Do not cook a young goat in its mother's milk.
- Deut. 26:18-19 And the LORD has declared this day that you are his people, his treasured possession as he promised, and that you are to keep all his commands. He has declared that he will set you in praise, fame and honor high above all the nations he has made and that you will be <u>a people holy to the LORD your God</u>, as he promised.

- Deut. 28:9 The LORD will establish you as <u>his holy people</u>, as he promised you on oath, if you keep the commands of the LORD your God and walk in his ways.
- Deut. 33:3-4 -- Surely it is you who love the people; <u>all the holy ones</u> are in your hand. At your feet they all bow down, and from you receive instruction, the law that Moses gave us, the possession of the assembly of Jacob.
- Isaiah 62:12 They will be called <u>the Holy People</u>, the Redeemed of the LORD; and you will be called Sought After, the City No Longer Deserted.
- Ezekiel 37:26-28 I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant. I will establish them and increase their numbers, and I will put my sanctuary among them forever. My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people. Then the nations will know that <u>I the LORD make Israel holy</u>, when my sanctuary is among them forever.'
- Ezekiel 39:27 When I have brought them back from the nations and have gathered them from the countries of their enemies, <u>I will show myself holy through them</u> in the sight of many nations.
- Ephesians 1:4 ...for he chose us in him before the creation of the world <u>to be holy</u> and blameless in his sight.
- 1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, <u>a holy nation</u>, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

They are God's possession, His inheritance, and His sheep.

- Exodus 19:5-6 Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my <u>treasured possession</u>. Although the whole earth is mine, you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.' These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites."
- Exodus 34:9 "O Lord, if I have found favor in your eyes," he said, "then let the Lord go with us. Although this is a stiff-necked people, forgive our wickedness and our sin, and take us as your inheritance."
- Deut. 7:6-7 For you are a people holy to the LORD your God. The LORD your God has chosen you out of all the peoples on the face of the earth to be his people, <u>his treasured possession</u>. The LORD did not set his affection on you and choose you because you were more numerous than other peoples, for you were the fewest of all peoples.
- Deut. 9:29 But they are your people, <u>your inheritance</u> that you brought out by your great power and your outstretched arm.
- Deut. 14:2 ...for you are a people holy to the LORD your God. Out of all the peoples on the face of the earth, the LORD has chosen you to be <u>his treasured possession</u>.
- 1 Kings 8:51-53 ...for they are your people and <u>your inheritance</u>, whom you brought out of Egypt, out of that iron-smelting furnace. May your eyes be open to your servant's plea and to

the plea of your people Israel, and may you listen to them whenever they cry out to you. For you singled them out from all the nations of the world to be <u>your own inheritance</u>, just as you declared through your servant Moses when you, O Sovereign LORD, brought our fathers out of Egypt.

- Psalm 33:12 Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD, <u>the people he chose for his</u> <u>inheritance</u>.
- Ezekiel 34:30-31 Then they will know that I, the LORD their God, am with them and that they, the house of Israel, are my people, declares the Sovereign LORD. <u>You my sheep, the sheep of my pasture</u>, are people, and I am your God, declares the Sovereign LORD.'
- Matthew 2:6 But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, are by no means least among the rulers of Judah; for out of you will come a ruler who will be <u>the shepherd of my people Israel</u>.
- John 10:14-16 "<u>I am the good shepherd</u>; I know my sheep and my sheep know me—just as the Father knows me and I know the Father—and I lay down my life for the sheep. They are redeemed.

You have established your people Israel as your very own forever, and you, O LORD, have become their God.
- 1 Chron. 17:21-22 And who is like your people Israel—the one nation on earth whose God went out <u>to redeem a people for himself</u>, and to make a name for yourself, and to perform great and awesome wonders by driving out nations from before your people, whom <u>you redeemed</u> <u>from Egypt</u>? You made your people Israel your very own forever, and you, O LORD, have become their God.
- Nehemiah 1:8 "Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name.' They are your servants and your people, <u>whom you redeemed</u> by your great strength and your mighty hand."
- Psalm 111:9 <u>He provided redemption for his people</u>; he ordained his covenant forever— holy and awesome is his name.

Even if you have been banished to the most distant land under the heavens, from there the LORD your God will gather you and bring you back. He will bring you to the land that belonged to your fathers, and you will take possession of it. He will make you more prosperous and numerous than your fathers. The LORD your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you <u>may love him with all your soul</u>, and live.

- 2 Chron. 6:27 ...then hear from heaven and forgive the sin of your servants, your people Israel. <u>Teach them the right way to live</u>, and send rain on the land you gave your people for an inheritance.
- 2 Chron. 36:16 But they mocked God's messengers, <u>despised his words</u> and scoffed at his prophets until the wrath of the LORD was aroused against his people and there was no remedy.
- Nehemiah 1:8 –" Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and <u>obey my</u> <u>commands</u>, then even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them

- Hosea 4:6 My people are destroyed from lack of knowledge. "Because you have rejected knowledge, I also reject you as my priests; <u>because you have ignored the law of your God</u>, I also will ignore your children.
- Micah 4:1-3 In the last days the mountain of the LORD's temple will be established as chief among the mountains; it will be raised above the hills, and peoples will stream to it. Many nations will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of

the God of Jacob. <u>He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion</u>, the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. He will judge between many peoples and will settle disputes for strong nations far and wide. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.

- Zephaniah 3:9-10 Then will I purify the lips of the peoples, that <u>all of them may call on the</u> <u>name of the LORD and serve him shoulder to shoulder</u>. From beyond the rivers of Cush my worshipers, my scattered people, will bring me offerings.
- Luke 1:68-75 Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel, because he has come and has redeemed his people. - Nehemiah 1:8 "Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, <u>I will scatter you among the nations</u>, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then <u>even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon</u>, I will gather them from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name.' They are your servants and your people, whom you redeemed by your great strength and your mighty hand."

- 1 Kings 8:51-53 ...for they are your people and your inheritance, whom you brought out of Egypt, out of that iron-smelting furnace. May your eyes be open to your servant's plea and to the plea of your people Israel, and <u>may you listen to them whenever they cry out to you</u>. For you singled them out from all the nations of the world to be your own inheritance, just as you declared through your servant Moses when you, O Sovereign LORD, brought our fathers out of Egypt.
- 2 Chron. 7:14 ...if my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, <u>then will I hear from heaven and will forgive</u> <u>their sin and will heal their land</u>.
- Nehemiah 1:8 "Remember the instruction you gave your servant Moses, saying, 'If you are unfaithful, I will scatter you among the nations, but if you return to me and obey my commands, then <u>even if your exiled people are at the farthest horizon, I will gather them</u> <u>from there and bring them to the place I have chosen as a dwelling for my Name</u>.' - Jeremiah 32:37-38 <u>I will surely gather them from all the lands where I banish them</u> in my furious anger and great wrath; <u>I will bring them back to this place and let them live in safety</u>. They will be my people, and I will be their God.
- Ezekiel 11:17 Therefore say: 'This is what the Sovereign LORD says: <u>I will gather you from the</u> <u>nations and bring you back from the countries where you have been scattered, and I will give</u> <u>you back the land of Israel again</u>.'
- Ezekiel 20:34, 41 <u>I will bring you from the nations and gather you from the countries where</u> <u>you have been scattered</u>—with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm and with outpoured wrath... I will accept you as fragrant incense when <u>I bring you out from the nations and</u> <u>gather you from the countries where you have been scattered</u>, and I will show myself holy among you in the sight of the nations.
- Ezekiel 28:25 This is what the Sovereign LORD says: <u>When I gather the people of Israel from</u> <u>the nations where they have been scattered</u>, I will show myself holy among them in the sight of the nations. <u>Then they will live in their own land</u>, which I gave to my servant Jacob.
- Ezekiel 34:13 <u>I will bring them out from the nations and gather them from the countries, and I will bring them into their own land</u>. I will pasture them on the mountains of Israel, in the ravines and in all the settlements in the land.

- Ezekiel 39:27 <u>When I have brought them back from the nations and have gathered them from</u> <u>the countries of their enemies</u>, I will show myself holy through them in the sight of many nations.
- Joel 2:18-19 Then <u>the LORD will be jealous for his land and take pity on his people</u>. The LORD will reply to them: "I am sending you grain, new wine and oil, enough to satisfy you fully; never again will I make you an object of scorn to the nations.
- Amos 9:14-15 <u>I will bring back my exiled people Israel</u>; they will rebuild the ruined cities and live in them. They will plant vineyards and drink their wine; they will make gardens and eat their fruit. <u>I will plant Israel in their own land, never again to be uprooted from the land I have given them</u>," says the LORD your God.

- Zechariah 8:7-8 This is what the LORD Almighty says: "<u>I will save my people from the</u> <u>countries of the east and the west. I will bring them back to live in Jerusalem;</u> they will be my people, and I will be faithful and righteous to them as their God."
- Zechariah 10:9 Though I scatter them among the peoples, <u>yet in distant lands they will</u> <u>remember me</u>. They and their children will survive, and <u>they will return</u>.
- Luke 1:68-75 Praise be to the Lord, the God of Israel, because he has come and has redeemed his people. He has raised up a horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David (as he said through his holy prophets of long ago), <u>salvation from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us</u>—to show mercy to our fathers and to remember his holy covenant, the oath he swore to our father Abraham: <u>to rescue us from the hand of our enemies</u>, and to enable us to serve him without fear in holiness and righteousness before him all our days.
- Ephesians 1:22 And God placed all things under his feet and appointed him to be head over everything for <u>the church [Greek, *ecclesia*, called-out ones]</u>.
- Revelation 18:4 Then I heard another voice from heaven say: "<u>Come out of [Babylon], my</u> <u>people</u>, so that you will not share in her sins, so that you will not receive any of her plagues...

He will circumcise their hearts.

Deut. 30:1-6 - When all these blessings and curses I have set before you come upon you and you take them to heart wherever the LORD your God disperses you among the nations, and when you and your children return to the LORD your God and obey him with all your heart and with all your soul according to everything I command you today, then the LORD your God will restore your fortunes and have compassion on you and gather you again from all the nations where he scattered you. Even if you have been banished to the most distant land under the heavens, from there the LORD your God will gather you and bring you back. He

will bring you to the land that belonged to your fathers, and you will take possession of it. He will make you more prosperous and numerous than your fathers. <u>The LORD your God will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you may love him with all your heart and with all your soul, and live</u>.

- Isaiah 51:7 Hear me, you who know what is right, <u>you people who have my law in your hearts</u>: Do not fear the reproach of men or be terrified by their insults.
- Jeremiah 24:7 <u>I will give them a heart to know me</u>, that I am the LORD. They will be my people, and I will be their God, for they will return to me with all their heart.
- Jeremiah 31:33 "This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time," declares the LORD. "<u>I will put my law in their minds and write it on their hearts</u>. I will be their God, and they will be my people.
- Romans 2:27-29 The one who is not circumcised physically and yet obeys the law will condemn you who, even though you have the written code and circumcision, are a lawbreaker. A man is not a Jew if he is only one outwardly, nor is circumcision merely outward and physical. No, a man is a Jew if he is one inwardly; and circumcision is circumcision of the heart, by the Spirit, not by the written code. Such a man's praise is not from men, but from God.
- Ephesians 2:11-13 Therefore, remember that formerly you who are Gentiles by birth and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (that done in the body by the hands of men)— remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. <u>But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near through the blood of Christ.</u>
- Philippians 3:3 For it is we who are the circumcision, <u>we who worship by the Spirit of God</u>, who glory in Christ Jesus, and who put no confidence in the flesh...
- Colossians 2:11 In him you were also circumcised, in the putting off of the sinful nature, not with a circumcision done by the hands of men but with the circumcision done by Christ...
- Hebrews 8:10-12 This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. <u>I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts</u>. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest. For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."

God will judge the nations because of His people Israel.

- Deut. 32:43 Rejoice, O nations, with his people, for <u>he will avenge the blood of his servants; he</u> will take vengeance on his enemies and make atonement for his land and people.
- Deut. 33:17 In majesty he is like a firstborn bull; his horns are the horns of a wild ox. With them <u>he will gore the nations, even those at the ends of the earth</u>. Such are the ten thousands of Ephraim; such are the thousands of Manasseh.

God will live among His people.

1 Kings 6:13 - And <u>I will live among the Israelites</u> and will not abandon my people Israel.

- Ezekiel 37:26-28 I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant. I will establish them and increase their numbers, and <u>I will put my sanctuary among them</u> <u>forever. My dwelling place will be with them</u>; I will be their God, and they will be my people. Then the nations will know that I the LORD make Israel holy, <u>when my sanctuary is among</u> <u>them forever</u>.'
- Micah 4:1-3 In the last days <u>the mountain of the LORD's temple</u> will be established as chief among the mountains; it will be raised above the hills, and peoples will stream to it. Many nations will come and say, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion, the word of the LORD from Jerusalem. He will judge between many peoples and will settle disputes for strong nations far and wide. They will beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning hooks. Nation will not take up sword against nation, nor will they train for war anymore.
- Ephesians 2:19-22 Consequently, you are no longer foreigners and aliens, but fellow citizens with God's people and members of God's household, built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, with Christ Jesus himself as the chief cornerstone. In him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. <u>And in him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit</u>.
- Revelation 21:3-4 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "<u>Now the dwelling of God</u> <u>is with men, and he will live with them</u>. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. He will wipe every tear from their eyes. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

There will be a rest for God's people, and He will wipe away all their tears.

- Isaiah 11:10-11, 16 In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner for the peoples; the nations will rally to him, and <u>his place of rest will be glorious</u>. In that day the Lord will reach out his hand a second time to reclaim the remnant that is left of his people from Assyria, from Lower Egypt, from Upper Egypt, from Cush, from Elam, from Babylonia, from Hamath and from the islands of the sea... There will be a highway for the remnant of his people that is left from Assyria, as there was for Israel when they came up from Egypt.
- Isaiah 25:8 The Sovereign LORD will <u>wipe away the tears from all faces</u>; he will remove the disgrace of his people from all the earth. The LORD has spoken.
- Isaiah 40:1 Comfort, comfort my people, says your God.
- Isaiah 52:9 Burst into songs of joy together, you ruins of Jerusalem, for <u>the LORD has</u> <u>comforted his people</u>, he has redeemed Jerusalem.
- Revelation 21:3-4 And I heard a loud voice from the throne saying, "Now the dwelling of God is with men, and he will live with them. They will be his people, and God himself will be with them and be their God. <u>He will wipe every tear from their eyes</u>. There will be no more death or mourning or crying or pain, for the old order of things has passed away.

He will save His people from their sins.

Matthew 1:21 - She will give birth to a son, and you are to give him the name Jesus, because he will <u>save his people from their sins</u>.

Luke 1:77 - ...to give his people <u>the knowledge of salvation through the forgiveness of their sins.</u> Hebrews 8:10-12 - This is the covenant I will make with the house of Israel after that time, declares the Lord. I will put my laws in their minds and write them on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be my people. No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest. <u>For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more</u>."

- Ephesians 1:7, 13 In him we have redemption through his blood, <u>the forgiveness of sins</u>, in accordance with the riches of God's grace... And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, <u>the gospel of your salvation</u>.
- 1 Peter 2:9-10 But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; <u>once you had not received mercy</u>, <u>but now you have received mercy</u>.

God has promised to bring back all His people, both Israel and Judah.

- Jeremiah 30:3 The days are coming,' declares the LORD, 'when I will bring <u>my people Israel</u> <u>and Judah</u> back from captivity and restore them to the land I gave their forefathers to possess,' says the LORD..."
- Jeremiah 31:1 "At that time," declares the LORD, "I will be the God <u>of all the clans of Israel</u>, and they will be my people."
- Jeremiah 33:24 "Have you not noticed that these people are saying, 'The LORD has rejected <u>the two kingdoms</u> he chose'? So they despise my people and no longer regard them as a nation."
- Ezekiel 37:22-23 I will make them <u>one nation</u> in the land, on the mountains of Israel. There will be one king over all of them and <u>they will never again be two nations or be divided into two kingdoms</u>. They will no longer defile themselves with their idols and vile images or with any of their offenses, for I will save them from all their sinful backsliding, and I will cleanse them. They will be my people, and I will be their God.
- Hosea 1:9-11 Then the LORD said, "Call him Lo-Ammi, for you are not my people, and I am not your God. Yet the Israelites will be like the sand on the seashore, which cannot be measured or counted. In the place where it was said to them, 'You are not my people,' they will be called 'sons of the living God.' <u>The people of Judah and the people of Israel will be reunited, and they will appoint one leader</u> and will come up out of the land, for great will be the day of Jezreel.
- Ephesians 1:9-10 And he made known to us the mystery of his will according to his good pleasure, which he purposed in Christ, to be put into effect when the times will have reached their fulfillment—to bring all things in heaven and on earth together under one head, even Christ.

Israel will be a "light for the Gentiles," and foreigners will be included with the people of God.

- Ruth 1:16 But Ruth replied, "Don't urge me to leave you or to turn back from you. Where you go I will go, and where you stay I will stay. <u>Your people will be my people</u> and your God my God.
- 1 Kings 8:41-43 "<u>As for the foreigner who does not belong to your people Israel but has come</u> <u>from a distant land because of your name</u>—for men will hear of your great name and your mighty hand and your outstretched arm—when he comes and prays toward this temple, then hear from heaven, your dwelling place, and do whatever the foreigner asks of you, so that all the peoples of the earth may know your name and fear you, as do your own people Israel, and may know that this house I have built bears your Name.
- 2 Chron. 6:32-33 <u>As for the foreigner who does not belong to your people Israel but has come</u> <u>from a distant land</u> because of your great name and your mighty hand and your outstretched arm—when he comes and prays toward this temple, then hear from heaven, your dwelling place, and do whatever the foreigner asks of you, so that all the peoples of the earth may know your name and fear you, as do your own people Israel, and may know that this house I have built bears your Name.
- Psalm 102:21-22 So the name of the LORD will be declared in Zion and his praise in Jerusalem when the peoples and the kingdoms assemble to worship the LORD.
- Isaiah 2:3 <u>Many peoples will come and say</u>, "Come, let us go up to the mountain of the LORD, to the house of the God of Jacob. He will teach us his ways, so that we may walk in his paths." The law will go out from Zion, the word of the LORD from Jerusalem.
- Isaiah 11:10-11, 16 In that day the Root of Jesse will stand as a banner <u>for the peoples; the</u> <u>nations will rally to him</u>, and his place of rest will be glorious. In that day the Lord will reach out his hand a second time to reclaim the remnant that is left of his people from Assyria, from Lower Egypt, from Upper Egypt, from Cush, from Elam, from Babylonia, from Hamath and from the islands of the sea... There will be a highway for the remnant of his people that is left from Assyria, as there was for Israel when they came up from Egypt.
- Isaiah 42:6-7 I, the LORD, have called you in righteousness; I will take hold of your hand. I will keep you and will make you to be a covenant for the people and <u>a light for the Gentiles</u>, to open eyes that are blind, to free captives from prison and to release from the dungeon those who sit in darkness.
- Isaiah 49:22 This is what the Sovereign LORD says: "See, <u>I will beckon to the Gentiles, I will</u> <u>lift up my banner to the peoples</u>; they will bring your sons in their arms and carry your daughters on their shoulders.
- Isaiah 56:3-<u>8 Let no foreigner who has bound himself to the LORD say, "The LORD will surely exclude me from his people</u>." And let not any eunuch complain, "I am only a dry tree." For this is what the LORD says: "To the eunuchs who keep my Sabbaths, who choose what pleases me and hold fast to my covenant—to them I will give within my temple and its walls a memorial and a name better than sons and daughters; <u>I will give them an everlasting name that will not be cut off. And foreigners who bind themselves to the LORD</u> to serve him, to

love the name of the LORD, and to worship him, all who keep the Sabbath without desecrating it and who hold fast to my covenant—these I will bring to my holy mountain and give them joy in my house of prayer. Their burnt offerings and sacrifices will be accepted on my altar; for my house will be called a house of prayer for all nations." The Sovereign LORD declares— he who gathers the exiles of Israel: "<u>I will gather still others to them besides those already gathered</u>."

- Zephaniah 3:9-10 Then will I purify the lips of <u>the peoples</u>, that <u>all of them may call on the</u> <u>name of the LORD</u> and serve him shoulder to shoulder. From beyond the rivers of Cush my worshipers, my scattered people, will bring me offerings.
- Zechariah 2:11 <u>Many nations</u> will be joined with the LORD in that day and <u>will become my</u> <u>people</u>. I will live among you and you will know that the LORD Almighty has sent me to you.
- Zechariah 8:20 This is what the LORD Almighty says: "<u>Many peoples and the inhabitants of</u> <u>many cities will yet come</u>..."
- Luke 2:30-32 For my eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all people, <u>a light for revelation to the Gentiles</u> and for glory to your people Israel.
- Luke 21:23-25 How dreadful it will be in those days for pregnant women and nursing mothers! There will be great distress in the land and wrath against this people. They will fall by the sword and will be taken as prisoners to all the nations. Jerusalem will be trampled on by the Gentiles <u>until the times of the Gentiles [returning to God]</u> are fulfilled. There will be signs in the sun, moon and stars...
- Acts 15:14-21 Simon has described to us how God at first showed his <u>concern by taking from</u> <u>the Gentiles a people for himself</u>. The words of the prophets are in agreement with this, as it is written: 'After this I will return and rebuild David's fallen tent. Its ruins I will rebuild, and I will restore it, that the remnant of men may seek the Lord, and <u>all the Gentiles who bear</u> <u>my name</u>, says the Lord, who does these things' that have been known for ages. It is my judgment, therefore, that we should not make it difficult for <u>the Gentiles who are turning to</u> <u>God</u>. Instead we should write to them, telling them to abstain from food polluted by idols, from sexual immorality, from the meat of strangled animals and from blood. For Moses has been preached in every city from the earliest times and is read in the synagogues on every Sabbath.
- Acts 26:23 ... that the Christ would suffer and, as the first to rise from the dead, would proclaim light to his own people and <u>to the Gentiles</u>.
- Romans 9:23-26 What if he did this to make the riches of his glory known to the objects of his mercy, whom he prepared in advance for glory—even us, whom he also called, not only from the Jews but <u>also from the Gentiles</u>? As he says in Hosea: "<u>I will call them 'my people</u>' who <u>are not my people</u>; and I will call her 'my loved one' who is not my loved one," and, "It will happen that in the very place where it was said to them, "<u>You are not my people</u>,' they will be <u>called 'sons of the living God</u>."
- Romans 15:8-12 For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs <u>so that the Gentiles may glorify God</u> <u>for his mercy</u>, as it is written: "Therefore I will praise you among the Gentiles; I will sing hymns to your name." Again, it says, "<u>Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people</u>." And again,

"<u>Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and sing praises to him, all you peoples</u>." And again, Isaiah says, "The Root of Jesse will spring up, one who will arise to rule over the nations; the <u>Gentiles will hope in him</u>."

Ephesians 1:13 – And <u>you [Gentiles] also were included in Christ</u> when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation.

- Ephesians 2:11-13 Therefore, remember that formerly <u>you who are Gentiles by birth</u> and called "uncircumcised" by those who call themselves "the circumcision" (that done in the body by the hands of men)— remember that at that time you were separate from Christ, excluded from citizenship in Israel and foreigners to the covenants of the promise, without hope and without God in the world. But <u>now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away have been brought near</u> through the blood of Christ.
- Ephesians 3:1-2 For this reason I, Paul, the prisoner of Christ Jesus for the sake of <u>you</u> <u>Gentiles—Surely you have heard about the administration of God's grace that was given to</u> <u>me for you</u>.
- Ephesians 3:6 This mystery is that through the gospel <u>the Gentiles are heirs together with</u> <u>Israel, members together of one body, and sharers together in the promise in Christ Jesus</u>.
- Revelation 7:9 After this I looked and there before me was <u>a great multitude that no one could</u> <u>count, from every nation, tribe, people and language</u>, standing before the throne and in front of the Lamb. They were wearing white robes and were holding palm branches in their hands.
- Revelation 14:6 Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth—to every nation, tribe, language and people.

His people have their names written in the book of life.

Daniel 12:1 - At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time <u>your people—everyone whose name is found written in the book</u>—will be delivered.

Philippians 4:3 - Yes, and I ask you, loyal yokefellow, help these women who have contended at my side in the cause of the gospel, along with Clement and the rest of my fellow workers, <u>whose</u> <u>names are in the book of life</u>.

- Revelation 3:5 He who overcomes will, like them, be dressed in white. <u>I will never blot out his</u> <u>name from the book of life</u>, but will acknowledge his name before my Father and his angels.
- Revelation 13:8 All inhabitants of the earth will worship the beast—<u>all whose names have not</u> <u>been written in the book of life belonging to the Lamb</u> that was slain from the creation of the world.
- Revelation 20:15, 27 <u>If anyone's name was not found written in the book of life</u>, he was thrown into the lake of fire.

Revelation 21:26-27 - The glory and honor of the nations will be brought into it. Nothing impure will ever enter it, nor will anyone who does what is shameful or deceitful, but <u>only those</u> whose names are written in the Lamb's book of life.

<u>Why will God fulfill these promises for His people?</u> So that all people and nations will know He is God and will praise Him.

- 1 Kings 8:59-60 And may these words of mine, which I have prayed before the LORD, be near to the LORD our God day and night, that he may uphold the cause of his servant and the cause of his people Israel according to each day's need, <u>so that all the peoples of the earth may know that the LORD is God and that there is no other</u>.
- Psalm 102:21-22 So the name of the LORD will be declared in Zion and his praise in Jerusalem when the peoples and the kingdoms assemble to worship the LORD.
- Isaiah 61:9 Their descendants will be known <u>among the nations</u> and their offspring <u>among the peoples</u>. <u>All who see them will acknowledge</u> that they are a people the LORD has blessed.
- Ezekiel 20:34, 41 I will bring you from the nations and gather you from the countries where you have been scattered—with a mighty hand and an outstretched arm and with outpoured wrath... I will accept you as fragrant incense when I bring you out from the nations and gather you from the countries where you have been scattered, and <u>I will show myself holy among you in the sight of the nations</u>.
- Ezekiel 28:25 This is what the Sovereign LORD says: When I gather the people of Israel from the nations where they have been scattered, <u>I will show myself holy among them in the sight of the nations</u>. Then they will live in their own land, which I gave to my servant Jacob.
- Ezekiel 37:26-28 I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant. I will establish them and increase their numbers, and I will put my sanctuary among them forever. My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people. <u>Then the nations will know that I the LORD make Israel holy</u>, when my sanctuary is among them forever.'
- Ezekiel 39:27 When I have brought them back from the nations and have gathered them from the countries of their enemies, <u>I will show myself holy through them in the sight of many nations</u>.
- Zephaniah 3:20 At that time I will gather you; at that time I will bring you home. I will give you honor and praise <u>among all the peoples of the earth</u> when I restore your fortunes before your very eyes," says the LORD.
- Luke 2:10 But the angel said to them, "Do not be afraid. I bring you good news of great joy that will be <u>for all the people</u>.
- Romans 15:8-12 For I tell you that Christ has become a servant of the Jews on behalf of God's truth, to confirm the promises made to the patriarchs <u>so that the Gentiles may glorify God</u> <u>for his mercy</u>, as it is written: "Therefore I will praise you <u>among the Gentiles</u>; I will sing hymns to your name." Again, it says, "Rejoice, O Gentiles, with his people." And again, "<u>Praise the Lord, all you Gentiles, and sing praises to him, all you peoples</u>." And again, Isaiah

says, "The Root of Jesse will spring up, one who will arise to rule over the nations; the Gentiles will hope in him."

1 Peter 2:9-10 - But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God, <u>that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness</u> <u>into his wonderful light</u>. Once you were not a people, but now you are the people of God; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

<u>Why is prophecy written?</u> Prophecy is written for the people of God, so that they will trust Him to always keep His Word.

- Deut. 26:18-19 And the LORD has declared this day that you are his people, his treasured possession <u>as he promised</u>, and that you are to keep all his commands. He has declared that he will set you in praise, fame and honor high above all the nations he has made and that you will be a people holy to the LORD your God, <u>as he promised</u>.
- Ezekiel 39:7-8 I will make known my holy name among my people Israel. I will no longer let my holy name be profaned, and the nations will know that I the LORD am the Holy One in Israel. <u>It is coming! It will surely take place</u>, declares the Sovereign LORD. This is the day I have spoken of.
- Daniel 9:24 Seventy 'sevens' are decreed <u>for your people</u> and your holy city to finish transgression, to put an end to sin, to atone for wickedness, to bring in everlasting righteousness, <u>to seal up vision and prophecy</u> and to anoint the most holy.
- Daniel 10:14 Now I have come to explain to you <u>what will happen to your people in the future</u>, for the vision concerns a time yet to come.
- Daniel 12:1 At that time Michael, the great prince who protects your people, will arise. There will be a time of distress such as has not happened from the beginning of nations until then. But at that time <u>your people</u>—everyone whose name is found written in the book—will be delivered.
- Daniel 12:7 The man clothed in linen, who was above the waters of the river, lifted his right hand and his left hand toward heaven, and I heard him swear by him who lives forever, saying, "It will be for a time, times and half a time. <u>When the power of the holy people has been finally broken, all these things will be completed.</u>"
- Matthew 4:16 ...the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those living in the land of the shadow of death a light has dawned. (a fulfillment of Isaiah 9:1-2)
- Matthew 13:15 For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them. (a fulfillment of Isaiah 6:9-10)
- Matthew 15:8 These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. (a <u>fulfillment of Isaiah 29:13)</u>

- Mark 7:6 He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written: "These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. (a fulfillment of Isaiah 29:13)
- Luke 1:17 And he will go on before the Lord, in the spirit and power of Elijah, to turn the hearts of the fathers to their children and the disobedient to the wisdom of the righteous—to make ready a people prepared for the Lord. (a fulfillment of Malachi 4:5-6)
- Acts 28:26-27 Go to this people and say, "You will be ever hearing but never understanding; you will be ever seeing but never perceiving." For this people's heart has become calloused; they hardly hear with their ears, and they have closed their eyes. Otherwise they might see with their eyes, hear with their ears, understand with their hearts and turn, and I would heal them. (a fulfillment of Isaiah 6:9-10)

Romans 11 is the best summary of the Bible's teaching about His people.

¹ I ask then: <u>Did God reject his people? By no means</u>! I am an Israelite myself, a descendant of Abraham, from the tribe of Benjamin. ² God did not reject his people, whom he foreknew. Don't you know what the Scripture says in the passage about Elijah—how he appealed to God against Israel: ³ "Lord, they have killed your prophets and torn down your altars; I am the only one left, and they are trying to kill me"? ⁴ And what was God's answer to him? "I have reserved for myself seven thousand who have not bowed the knee to Baal." ⁵ So too, at the present time there is a remnant chosen by grace. ⁶ And if by grace, then it is no longer by works; if it were, grace would no longer be grace.

⁷ What then? What Israel sought so earnestly it did not obtain, but the elect did. The others were hardened, ⁸ as it is written:

"God gave them a spirit of stupor, eyes so that they could not see and ears so that they could not hear, to this very day."

9 And David says:

"May their table become a snare and a trap, a stumbling block and a retribution for them. ¹⁰ May their eyes be darkened so they cannot see, and their backs be bent forever."

¹¹ Again I ask: Did they stumble so as to fall beyond recovery? Not at all! Rather, because of their transgression, <u>salvation has come to the Gentiles to make Israel envious</u>. ¹² But if their transgression means riches for the world, and their loss means riches for the Gentiles, how much greater riches will their fullness bring!

¹³ I am talking to you Gentiles. Inasmuch as I am the apostle to the Gentiles, I make much of my ministry ¹⁴ in the hope that I may somehow arouse my own people to envy and save some of them. ¹⁵ For if their rejection is the reconciliation of the world, what will their acceptance be but life from the dead? ¹⁶ If the part of the dough offered as firstfruits is holy, then the whole batch is holy; if the root is holy, so are the branches.

¹⁷ If some of the branches have been broken off, and you, though a wild olive shoot, <u>have been</u> grafted in among the others and now share in the nourishing sap from the olive root, ¹⁸ do not boast over those branches. If you do, consider this: You do not support the root, but the root supports you. ¹⁹ You will say then, "Branches were broken off so that I could be grafted in." ²⁰ Granted. But they were broken off because of unbelief, and you stand by faith. Do not be arrogant, but be afraid. ²¹ For if God did not spare the natural branches, he will not spare you either.

²² Consider therefore the kindness and sternness of God: sternness to those who fell, but kindness to you, provided that you continue in his kindness. Otherwise, you also will be cut off. ²³ And if they do not persist in unbelief, they will be grafted in, for God is able to graft them in again. ²⁴ After all, if you were cut out of an olive tree that is wild by nature, and contrary to nature were grafted into a cultivated olive tree, <u>how much more readily will these</u>, the natural branches, be grafted into their own olive tree!

²⁵ I do not want you to be ignorant of this mystery, brothers, so that you may not be conceited: Israel has experienced a hardening in part <u>until the full number of the Gentiles has come in</u>. ²⁶ And so all Israel will be saved, as it is written:

"The deliverer will come from Zion; he will turn godlessness away from Jacob. ²⁷ And this is my covenant with them when I take away their sins."

²⁸ As far as the gospel is concerned, they are enemies on your account; but as far as election is concerned, they are loved on account of the patriarchs, ²⁹ for God's gifts and his call are irrevocable. ³⁰ Just as you who were at one time disobedient to God have now received mercy as a result of their disobedience, ³¹ so they too have now become disobedient in order that they too may now receive mercy as a result of God's mercy to you. ³² For God has bound all men over to disobedience so that he may have mercy on them all.

³³ Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and knowledge of God! How unsearchable his judgments, and his paths beyond tracing out!
³⁴ "Who has known the mind of the Lord? Or who has been his counselor?"
³⁵ "Who has ever given to God, that God should repay him?"
³⁶ For from him and through him and to him are all things. To him be the glory forever! Amen.
