The Purpose of the Second Exodus

- To show the holiness of His great Name among the nations.
 - Ezekiel 36:22-32
 - Note: Be sure to read all of Ezekiel 36-39.
- There is a progression to the Second Exodus (Deuteronomy 30)
 - First, repent and obey.
 - The blessings and curses listed in Deuteronomy 28.
 - Deuteronomy 28:64 – He would scatter them among the nations.
 - Then He will make you prosperous and return you to the Land.

Why is the Second Exodus called this?

- Jeremiah 16:14-15

Who is involved in the Second Exodus?

- The Bride
 - Defined as those who holds to the testimony of Yeshua and guards His commandments (Revelation 14:12).
 - Her robes are clean (Revelation 19:7-8).
 - The Bride is also known as the Two Houses of Israel.
 - 10 Northern Tribes (House of Israel, or Ephraim)
 - Some of Christianity (Holds to the testimony of Yeshua)
 - 2 Southern Tribes (House of Judah, or Jews)
 - Some of Judaism (Guards His commandments, Romans 3:1-2)
 - 12,000 from each tribe sealed (Revelation 7:3-17)
 - The Bride represents those in the First Resurrection.
 - Those of the Bride who have fallen asleep rise first (1 Thessalonians 4:13-18).
 - Many of the dead in Messiah have been beheaded/martyred for their faith.
 - Those of the Bride who are alive at Yeshua's coming (Revelation 20:4).
 - Caught up in the clouds: Both literal and symbolic fulfillment possible (Zechariah 10:6-12; Ezekiel 34:13).
 - Brought on mules and camels (physical transportation) (Isaiah 66:20).
 - Brought as a harvest offering to YHVH (Isaiah 66:20).
 - The Brides is also known as the Priests of God.
 - Righteous priestly line of Zadok (Ezekiel 44).
 - Isaiah 66:21
 - 1 Peter 2:9

- The Nations
 - Isaiah 11:9-10
 - Habakkuk 2:14
 - Isaiah 49:6-7
 - Zechariah 14:16-21
 - Revelation 19:15
 - Isaiah 27:6
 - Zechariah 8:20
 - Note: The Bride is currently scattered among all the nations.
 - Amos 9:9
 - Psalm 106:47
 - Hosea 7:8; 8:8; 10:13
- The Kings of the Earth
 - Revelation 17-18
 - Proverbs 10:25
 - Psalm 2:1-3

 - Agenda of the New World Order:
 - Abolish ordered government
 - Abolish private property
 - Abolish inheritance
 - Abolish patriotism
 - Abolish family
 - Abolish religion
 - Abolish humanity (<500 million world population)
 - Establish one-world government
 - 2 Thessalonians 2:5-8

Where are all of these groups now, and where will they end up?

- The Kings of the Earth will be destroyed (Revelation 16:16-21; 19:11-21).
- The Bride has been scattered but nourished in the wilderness.
 - Ezekiel 20:33-38 (also see vs. 5, 21, 23, 41)
 - Revelation 12
- The Bride will be taken to the Land of Israel.
 - Leviticus 25:54-55; 26:1-13
 - Zechariah 14:16-19
- The Nations will be taught obedience to the Torah and proper worship of YHVH.

What is going to happen during the Second Exodus?

- Restore Justice and the Law of Torah
 - Isaiah 11:1-5
- Restore His Name and a Pure Language
 - Zechariah 13:1-2
 - Zechariah 14:9
 - Malachi 1:11
 - Ezekiel 39:7-8
 - Zephaniah 3:9
 - Nehemiah 13:23-24
- Grant Jubilee
 - Isaiah 61:1-2 (read all of Isaiah 60-66)
- Restore the reign and government of Yeshua
 - Revelation 19:11-16
- Repentance and Return
 - Jeremiah 3:12-18

How is He going to set up His Torah?

- Genesis 49:10
- Matthew 28:18
- Jeremiah 33:20-22
- Revelation 18:2
- Hebrew 9
- Ezekiel 44:15-31
- Isaiah 11:6-16
- Isaiah 65:20
- 1 Corinthians 15:50-57
 - Note: This takes place at the same time as Revelation 20:14, when death is thrown into the lake of fire.
- Deuteronomy 30:9-10

When is the Second Exodus going to happen?

- On the third day
 - Hosea 6:1-2
 - Ezekiel 4:4-5, 13
 - Leviticus 26:18
 - 390 years x 7-fold punishment = 2,730 years)
 - 2 Peter 3:8
- After the latter rains
 - Hosea 6:3
- At the time of the harvest
 - Harvest of First Fruits – the First Resurrection (1 Corinthians 15:20-28)
 - Harvest of Shavuot – the Torah written on hearts by the Holy Spirit (Ezekiel 36:27)
 - Harvest of Sukkot – the rest of the nations worship YHVH

- As in the days of Noah
 - Matthew 24:37-41
 - Luke 17:26-29
 - Revelation 16:12-16
 - Amos 3:7
 - Zechariah 9:14-17
 - The seventh bowl (Revelation 16:17-21)
- After the Root of Jesse has sprung up
 - Isaiah 11:1, 10-16
- After the battle against the Kings of the Earth
 - Zechariah 14:3-5
- At the time of the First Resurrection
 - Isaiah 25-27 (especially Isaiah 26:19)
 - Revelation 20:4-6
- Extra: At His Coming with clouds of judgment (aka. the Day of YHVH)
 - Zechariah 14:1
 - 1 Corinthians 5:5
 - 2 Corinthians 1:14
 - 1 Thessalonians 5:1-11
 - 2 Peter 3:10
